

Celebration of Khenmaat



Khenmaat is a celebration of Truth, Balance, Order, Law, Morality, and Justice, known as the Egyptian principals of Ma'at, held in honor of the goddess Ammit who enforces judgment in the afterlife. Also playing minor roles in Khenmaat are the god of the underworld, Anubis, who bears the head of the golden wolf and the goddess of truth, Ma'at, who gave the universe order out of chaos and continues guiding the stars and regulating seasons.

Khenmaat's Symbolism

Revealing occulted wisdom is a cornerstone of Khenmaat for the acts of evil secret themselves away from justice. Some celebrate Khenmaat by telling their own dark secrets during this time to lighten the burden of their hearts, others prefer to expose someone else's misdeeds, but all seek out new sources of hidden knowledge. Whether to seek judgment, come clean, or whisper naughty nothings Khenmaat's celebration of truth is balanced by the presence of its opposite: Secrecy, chaos and lies. Tradition says to share at least one secret each day of Khenmaat before the second hour of night which belongs to Ammit.

The favored ceremonial stone of Khenmaat is red jasper which Egyptians called khenmet. Its ancient name is derived from a verb meaning "to delight", and has a striking red hue symbolizing purifying flame. Ammit's nightly rule adds an element of darkness making Black and Red or Reddish Orange the preferred colors of Khenmaat decorations. The color of flame opposes the shroud of midnight. Some have remarked that the red stone khenmet bears similarity to the modern day "red pill" which also invokes the spirit of Khenmaat celebrations.

Few single events bear out the principals of Ma'at and Ammit as completely as the little known Lavon Affair. This foiled secret Israeli plot to bomb Egyptians, Americans and Brits was coincidentally tried in court over the duration of Khenmaat. For this reason many observers of Khenmaat recount this conspiracy relating its happenings through the 14 Khenmaat celebrations.



14 Rituals of Khenmaat

December 11th of the Gregorian calendar begins the first of Khenmaat's fourteen festivities which conclude on January 17th. The following celebrations mark the observances of Khenmaat. Not everyone partakes of every event on its given day, but most practice at least some of the celebrations during Khenmaat. Many rituals are practiced throughout the year and the year's accounting of such deeds is then retold during Khenmaat.

December 11 - Strengthening of Nations

Without a strong nation the principals of Ma'at can not be maintained nor justice meted out. On this day promote nationalism, community, and preservation of tradition. Prepare a wholesome meal of your nation's traditional foods or those of your ancestors. Take part in favored national pastimes. Be sure to invite others to take part in Khenmaat.

In the early 1950s, the United States initiated a more activist policy of support for Egyptian nationalism.

December 13 - Frustration of Enemies

Through temptation the virtuous wheat is separated from the undesirable chaff. Bait is made for our enemies and efforts taken to thwart and make light of their futile actions. Clever ruses are employed to cause our foes cognitive dissonance. Salt is mined, Tears drank, and butthurt abounds. Keep all of your snackbars nearby.

Israel sought to influence [Egyptian Nationalism] through diplomatic means but was frustrated.



December 17 - Night of Secret Plotting

Plans are made and strategies discussed to protect the community and stave off destructive forces. Khenmaat decorations are hung and shrines adorned by the 17th. Some observers hang a sleeping bag up or make bedding arrangements in a ploy to attract Ammit or one of her daughters. It's suggested to meditate by candlelight upon preparations made while quietly enjoying the favorite meal of Ammit, a salad, or a dish one of Ammit's daughters would prefer.

Colonel Binyamin Gibli, the chief of Israel's military intelligence, Aman, initiated Operation Susannah [...]. The goal of the Operation was to carry out bombings and other acts of sabotage in Egypt. The top-secret cell, Unit 131, which was to carry out the operation, had existed since 1948 and under Aman since 1950.

December 19 - Day of Enemy Subversion


Justice can not prevail if good men say nothing. Warn people of subversive practices of the enemy. Search out the hiding places of evil. Speculate on conspiracies, point out threats by those plotting against us. Immunize others from useful idiocy by delivering red pills of knowledge and carrying out the plans discussed on the Night of Secret Plotting.

December 23 - Recruitment of Useful Idiots

Raise awareness of the dangers illegal emigration poses. Try to enlist the aid of ordinary people and strangers to promote our messages via fliers and infographics. Hashjack and false flag enemy hashtags, to spread our memes and combat enemy propaganda. Have some mint to honor Ammit with your meal, as a garnish, or in refreshing drinks to keep your spirits up and your mind fresh.

Unit 131 operatives had been recruited several years before, when the Israeli intelligence officer Avram Dar arrived in Cairo under the cover of a British citizen from Gibraltar named John Darling. He had recruited several Egyptian Jews who had previously been active in illegal emigration activities and trained them for covert operations.



December 29 - Passing of the Black Sun's Shadow

Honor past Heroes that strike fear into the hearts of enemies. Tactical clothing can disguise you from prying eyes, or shield you from accusation by donning garb that agrees and amplifies baseless claims into absurdity. Why not dress up as a Nazi? Post pictures of people in SS uniforms, and promote various NatSoc imagery (which also tends to feature black and red). Commission and display art of Ammit and her daughters cosplaying in Nazi uniform.

Before the [terrorists] began the operation, Israeli agent Avri Elad (Avraham Seidenwerg) was sent to oversee the operations. Elad assumed the identity of Paul Frank, a former SS officer with Nazi underground connections.

December 31 - Attack of Terror

Stay alert and aware! If you sense anything alarming spread word that it's happening to warn people of the grave futures they choose which they could have prevented if only they had listened! Tell tales of past terror attacks so that others may recognize the patterns to watch out for. Point out inconsistencies and know the signs of the False Flag and inside jobs. January 2 - The Fire Rises

The homemade bombs, consisting of bags containing acid placed over nitroglycerine, were inserted into books, and placed on the shelves of the libraries just before closing time. Several hours later, as the acid ate through the bags, the bombs would explode.

January 3 - Naming of the Enemy

There is power in names. To name a thing is to gain a measure of control over it. Evil breeds best in secret, so Name the Enemy! The adventurous may locate and reveal more than mere names. Also report the activities, writings, videos and accounts of our foes. Record any connections made to research later.

January 5 - Purification by Flame

Commemorate the epic failure of our enemies and the poetic justice of a liar with his pants on fire. Some observers of this celebration use fireworks to recreate the fatal folly of our foes exploding themselves. Images of enemies are shared with flames added, others are burned in effigy. Set alight the propaganda of our enemies and delight in the foolish predicaments they make for themselves.

Avri Elad allegedly informed the Egyptians, resulting in the Egyptian Intelligence Service following a suspect to his target, the Rio Theatre, where a fire engine was standing by. Egyptian authorities arrested this suspect, Philip Natanson, when his bomb accidentally ignited prematurely in his pocket.



January 7 - Vigil of Justice



Offer your constant vigilance by burning candles and kyphi incense. Those who managed to escape justice will surely face judgment in the hereafter. Let not those who obstruct the law escape blame. They who knowingly let the guilty escape bear fresh guilt of their own. Point out those who bind the hands of the law and harm the community and nation thereby.

Several suspects were arrested, including Egyptian Jews and undercover Israelis. Colonel Dar and Elad had managed to escape. Two suspects, Yosef Carmon and Israeli Meir Max Bineth committed suicide in prison.

January 11 - Trial of Hearts

The climax of the Khenmaat Holiday, we commemorate the testing of hearts by Anubis. To proceed on ones journey to immortality Anubis must judge one's heart by weighing it upon a balance against a feather from the helm of Ma'at. This is our reminder to live by the principals of Ma'at and judge fairly. Milk and honey is set out for Ammit on this night. Offerings are also made to the daughters of Ammit.

The Egyptian trial began on 11 December and lasted until 27 January 1955.



January 13 - Feast of Souls

Justice is served and divine punishment is carried out. Only the pure of heart pass the test of Anubis and continue towards Osiris and ever lasting life. Corrupt hearts are fed to Ammit or tossed into the lake of fire she presides over, and those souls are damned to eternal restlessness. Hold a feast in Ammit's honor thanking her for our serving of Justice. If you've hung a sleeping bag or made inviting bedding now would be a good time to check its contents and maybe spend a night being pleasing to Ammit or one of her daughters.



[T]wo of the accused (Moshe Marzouk and Shmuel Azar) were condemned to execution by hanging, two were acquitted, and the rest received lengthy prison terms.

January 17 - Battle of Silence

Seek ways to prevent our messages from being silenced. To fight censorship we spread our love for Ammit and her Daughters and sew the seeds for new followers to find the path of light. In darkness the red stone of khenmet is balanced upon images our enemies and symbols of other things which weigh upon our hearts tonight. Khenmaat is concluded when the rising sun illuminates the fiery stone and casts away its veil of shadows. When our hearts have been lifted so too is the khenmet.

The trial was criticized in Israel as a show trial, although strict Israeli military censorship of the press, at the time, meant that the Israeli public was kept in the dark about the facts of the case and, in fact, were led to believe that the defendants were innocent.

After Israel publicly denied any involvement in the incident for 51 years, the surviving [terrorists] were officially honored in 2005 by being awarded certificates of appreciation by Israeli President Moshe Katzav.
