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# EYE'S ULTIMATE MONETIZING GUIDE

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*If you don't have CPALead, Leadbolt, or any other content unlocking network account I suggest you get one right now. They are, in my opinion, the easiest and most efficient affiliate networks for generating large sums of cash. I use Leadbolt, and I'll be using it as an example for showing you one of my many monetizing methods.*

Unlike most eBooks, let's get straight to the point:

1. First we need to set up our page. If you don't have one yet, create a Wordpress account [here](#). The blog address can be anything you like, really.
2. Download a cracked version of Auto Blog Samurai [here](#). Use it to get some posts on your blog (which would also get you accepted on affiliate networks), it's pretty self-explanatory. Here are the instructions just in case:

The *Add New Blog* window will appear like in the image right.

Step 1: Choose if you would like to add either a *WordPress* Blog or the Free *Blogger.com* blog.

Step 2: Once you have chosen *WordPress*, enter the Blog URL or the exact address of your blog.

Example:

<http://www.YourBlogName.com>



Step 3: Enter a name to identify your Blog. What you type here does not matter with anything you've configured on your blog but will just be used to identify the particular blog within the software, like in the *Blog List Pane*.

Step 4: Now enter the user name and password of any admin or author account on your blog so the software can successfully login and post to your blog.

**Important:** You must enable XML RPC remote publishing protocols on your blog. In simple words, it is a service built into WordPress that allows software like this to make posts on your blog. By default, the feature is turned off and you must indeed enable it for the software to work properly.

You can enable this feature on a single click by visiting the admin area of your WordPress blog and select it from Settings > Writing menu.

Step 5: Here you enter a minimum and maximum interval between which a random interval is chosen for every post made by the software.

For example, if you enter 3 and 5 and choose hours from the drop-down, every post will be scheduled randomly between 3 to 5 hours. Like the first post at 3.4 hours, next at 4.5 hours and so on.

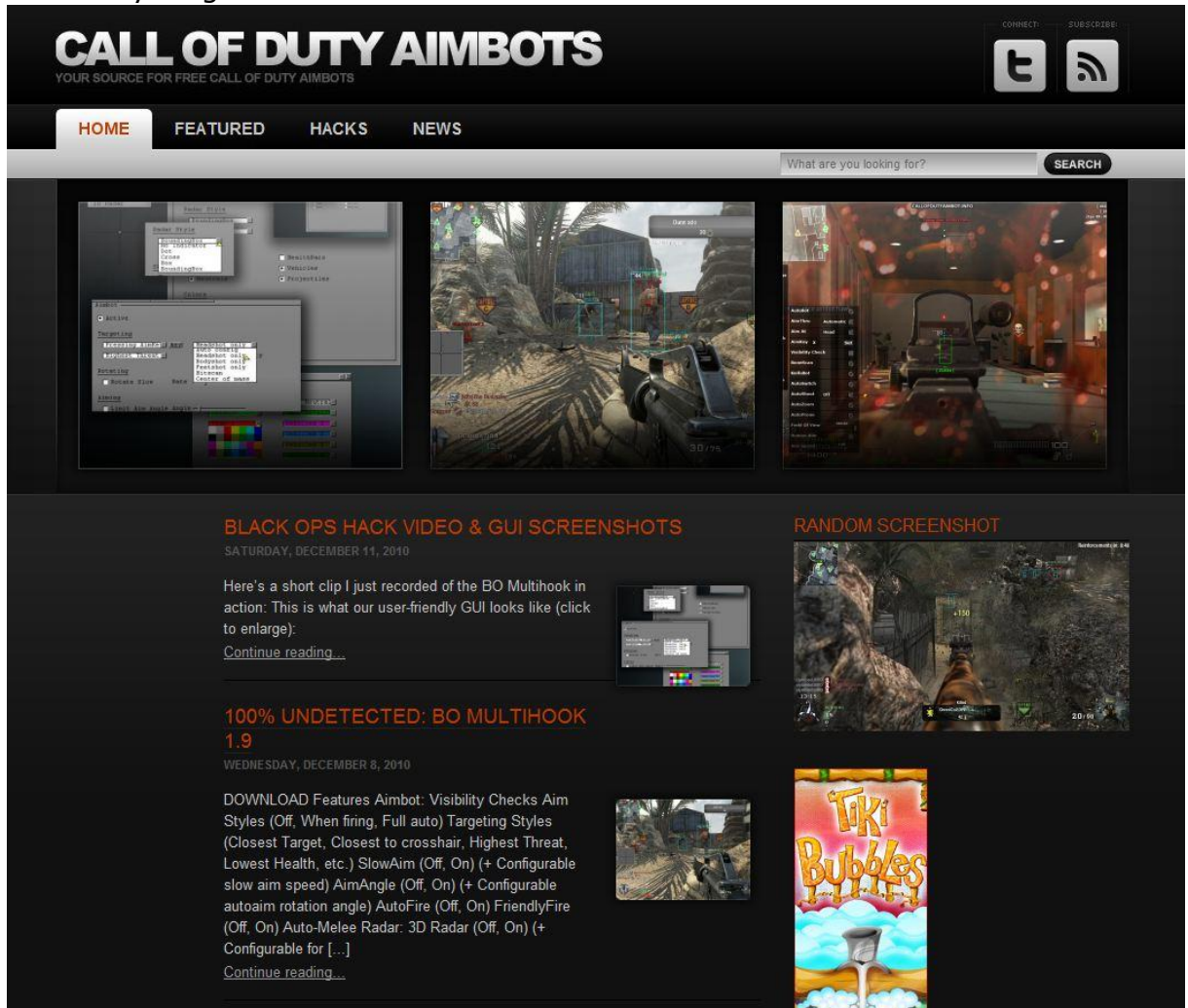
This does not mean the software will wait have to be running for the time to expire until next post is made. ABS 2.0 will make the posts immediately and automatically schedules it on the blog to be published only on the future dates which will then be handled by the blog itself.

Finally, press the *Check and Add Blog* button. The software will then check if the settings are correct and prompt you if any modifications are required or else will add the blog to its list.

Once the blog is added, it will be listed in the *Blog List Pane* and the software will ask if you would like to add any feeds at the moment and you can choose yes or no to the option.

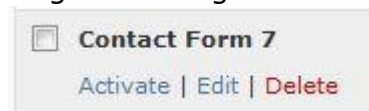
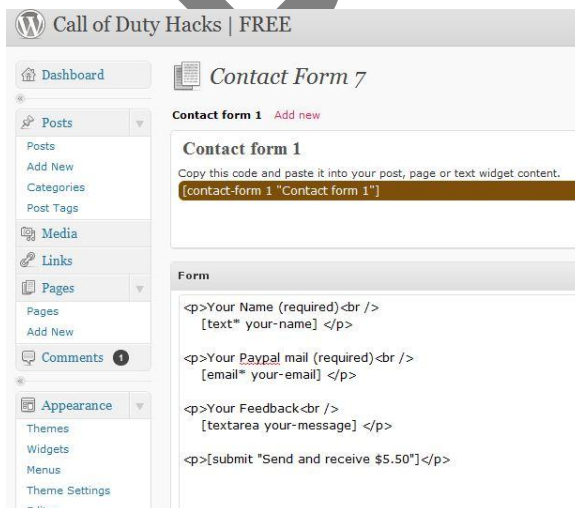


3. This is my blog:



I have installed Wordpress on my own hosting with FTP, which allows me to install external plugins and themes. You could do this too, but you don't have to for this method. **If you don't have WP on your OWN hosting skip this step.**

If you have Wordpress installed on your own hosting you can go ahead and install this plugin called [Contact Form 7](#). It lets you create a simple but flexible contact form. You just need to copy the contents to wp-content/plugins (guide [here](#)). Once installed go to Plugins -> Plugins -> Activate.



Now hit settings.



Copy in the following code (also available [here](#)), and hit save:

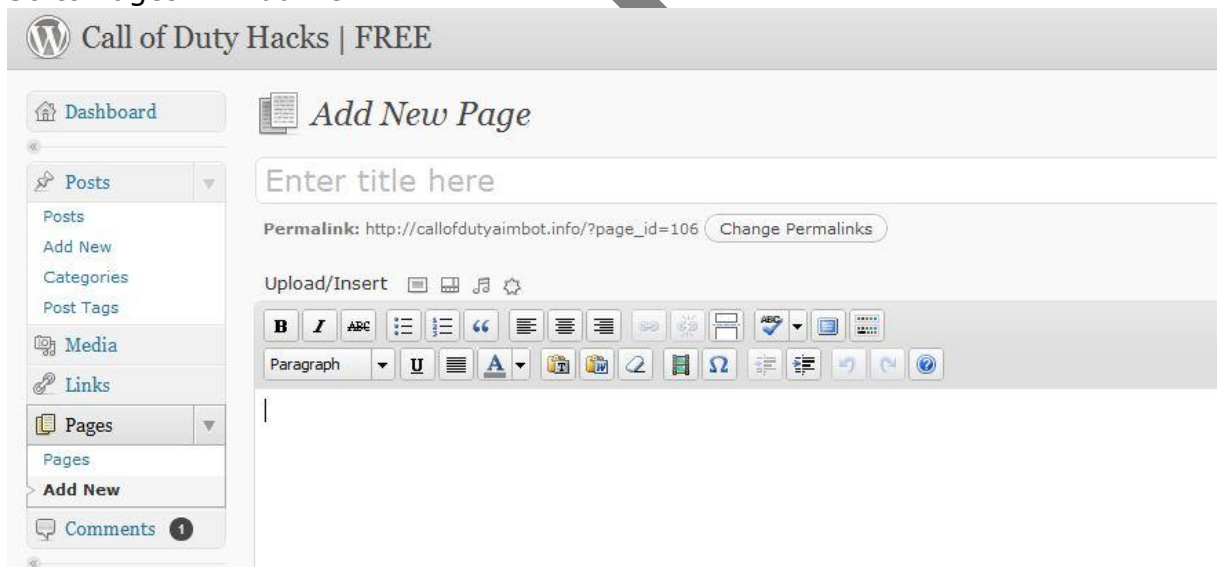

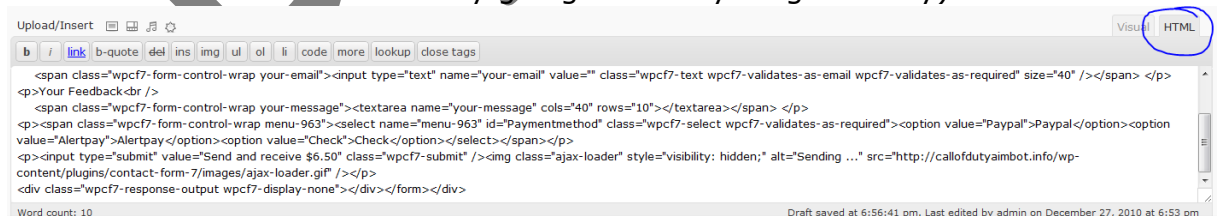

#### 4. Go to Pages -> Add New




If you did step 3 right you can simply enter a title and type in **[contact-form 1 "Contact form 1"]**

If you didn't do step 3 enable HTML and paste in [this](#) code (the only difference is that it's not actually going to do anything this way):




This should be your result:



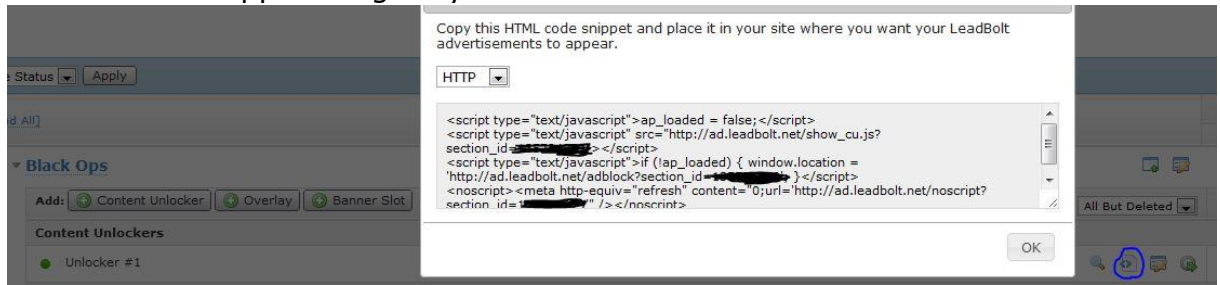
The 'Share and Enjoy!' you see at the bottom is a great viral plugin called [SexyBookmarks](#).

5. Next we're going to put our Leadbolt/CPALead lock over it.

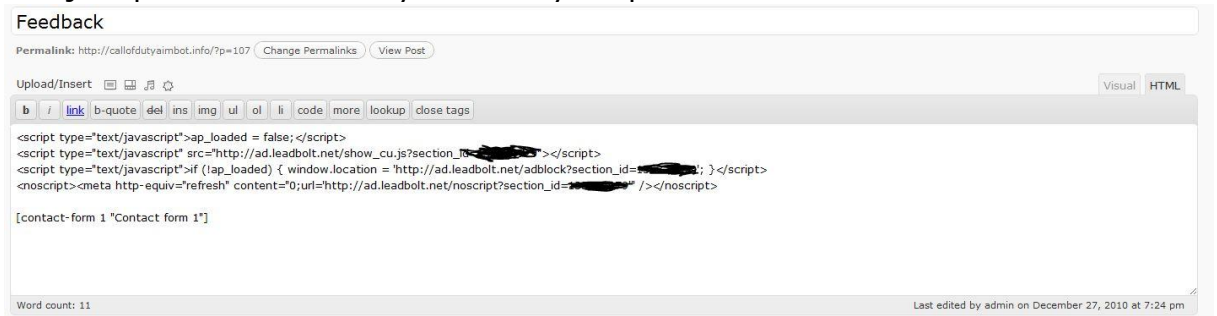
Go to Leadbolt and create a new unlocker:



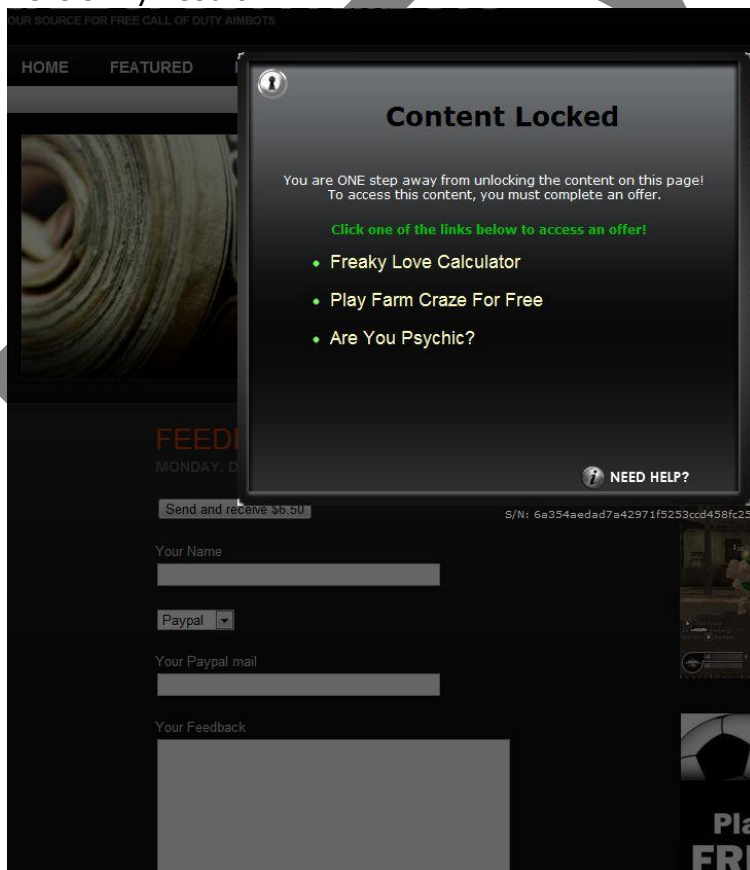
Once it's been approved grab you code:



And just paste the code anywhere in your post.

6. Ladies and gentlemen, it's time to start spreading our page! You'll need to find job offering websites such as:

- Craigslist: <http://www.craigslist.org/about/sites>
- Minute Workers: <http://www.minuteworkers.com/>
- Kijiji - <http://www.ebayclassifieds.com/>
- PostJobsFree - <http://www.postjobsfree.com/>

There are many more job websites. The more you can find, the Better it is. Also, high traffic job sites such as Minute Workers charge per job postings and will get you more revenue.

After you've signed up at a couple of sites submit your job; writing a professional job offer is crucial! Here's an example:

*Hello,*

*We are a global third-party software company that just created a new \*\*\* website. We're still in a free BETA-stage and we'd like to hear from you, in order to improve our service before we start officially. Therefore we are paying 150 participants to take a look at our website and tell us what we should add/change on our website.*
