

**Industrialized Art
and the
Monopolization of Free Speech**

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HEAT CANNOT BE SEPARATED FROM FIRE, OR BEAUTY FROM THE ETERNAL, said the poet Dante Alighieri. Yet we nowadays live under a brutal, though transparent regime that desperately tries to deform the meaning of beauty. Real beauty is, at the very best, a rare commodity in these modern days we live in, and art is a weapon of mass destruction at the hands of our invisible tyrants. Art is an ancient practice of communication, a communication between peers, between the past and the future and between man and the Divine. Art is the expression of one's self and beyond, and art is one of the most important and undisputed elements that create and conserve Culture and Tradition. The art of our ancestors is a part of our identity, and this identity reaches far beyond the individual subject and touches a whole Nation, even a whole race. To deny your art is to deny your Nation, your destiny, your own blood.

Of course, to provide clarification and to give a face to the writer of this piece, it must be expressed that I myself stand not against modern art. In a civilized society one should always have the right to express themselves the way they see fit. It is the Authority's job to always promote the right values for its People, but never banish elements just because it disagrees with them on a theoretical level, unless of course the opposers of Authority use extreme and dangerous means.
